


Mascot Station Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

May 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing construction of the Mascot Station Upgrade as part of the More Trains, More Services program.

Key features of the work include:

- new integrated entrance and exit into Mascot Station which provides a place for community interaction
- escalators and a lift to the lower/paid concourse
- additional ticket gates
- new toilets in the paid concourse of the station.

What work are we doing?

During May there will be ongoing works to the new western entry, existing station, and on Bourke Street.

Work includes:

- electrical work
- hoarding removal
- minor road work where required
- saw-cutting
- demolition of concrete walls
- building fit-out and installation of services within the new western entry
- structural steel installation
- cladding and glazing
- installation of new circuits in main switchboards within Mascot Station
- defect rectification as required within the station
- concourse tiling.

When and where we'll be working

Our construction hours are between **7am** and **6pm** Monday to Friday and **7am** and **6pm** on Saturdays.

The work will take place in the new western entry, concourse level of Mascot Station and within the worksite on the western side of Bourke Street.

During the out-of-hours work there will be deliveries of equipment, machinery and materials.

To carry out the work, the construction workers will be using hand-held tools, a forklift, jackhammers, concrete saws, concrete pumps and generators, excavators and other construction plant.

Out-of-hours work

The team will be continuing tiling work including, demolition of existing tiles and installation of new tiles at the lower concourse area of the station. This work will take place for up to five nights per week during the month of May. The team will also be undertaking new circuit installation works on the main switchboards at the lower and upper concourse areas of Mascot Station. This work will take place for up to two nights during the month of May.

The work will be inaudible due to the area in which the work is taking place.

Materials and plant will be transported to and from the concourse level for the duration of these works. The activities will be taking place during off peak hours and while the station is closed.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

This work may be noisy however, every effort will be made to minimise noise to the community.

This work is dependent on-site conditions and is subject to change. We will notify you if the dates and times of work change.

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill.
