## Out-of-hours work

### Mascot Station Upgrade More Trains, More Services

February 2023

Transport for NSW is continuing construction of the Mascot Station Upgrade as part of the More Trains, More Services program.

#### What work are we doing?

##### Tiling works

From **8:00pm Friday 17 February to 5:00am Monday 20 February 2023**, the team will be demolishing the existing floor tiles and installing new tiles at the lower concourse area of the station.

Materials and plant will be transported between the street and concourse level for the duration of these works.

This activity will be taking place during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

##### Removal of hoarding

On **Monday 20 February** and **Tuesday 21 February 2023** from **8:00pm to 4:00am**, work will include the removal of hoarding at the north and south ends of the worksite and the installation of temporary fencing with shade cloth. This work may be noisy however, every effort will be made to minimise noise to the community. Any impacted residents will be contacted individually.

#### When we'll be working

The works will take place out of standard construction hours. Standard construction hours are between **7:00am and 6:00pm Monday to Friday** and **8:00am and 1:00pm on Saturdays**.

#### Where we'll be working

The work will take place at the lower and upper concourse levels of Mascot Station and the perimeter of the Bourke Street worksite.

As part of the out-of-hours work there will be deliveries of equipment, machinery and materials.

To carry out the work, the construction workers will be using hand-held tools and a forklift.

#### Managing our impacts

We don't expect this work to be noisy and every effort will be made to minimise disruption to the community. This work is dependent on-site conditions and is subject to change. We will notify you if the dates and times of work change.
