What's been happening?

Work is progressing on the Mascot Station Access upgrade which includes a brand new entrance/exit on the western side of Bourke Street, additional ticket gates, new escalators and a lift to the paid concourse area.

The upgrade will ensure this busy transport hub can meet the needs of our customers now and into the future. When complete the upgrade will provide greater convenience for train customers, and road users will notice reduced congestion on Bourke Street with less people having to rely on the pedestrian crossing to access the station.

Upcoming changes to Saturday construction hours

In the July Mascot Precinct Update notification, we advised you that work on the upgrade had been adversely affected by the impacts of COVID on the construction workforce over the past 18 months, together with the extreme rain events that we have encountered.

To make up for lost time on our construction program we are extending working hours on Saturdays from **8am to 1pm** to **7am to 6pm**. This change will take effect from **Saturday 23 July 2022 and will remain in place through to project completion in early 2023**.

We understand that work during these extended hours will generate some noise and inconvenience in the area.

We will provide updates in the monthly Mascot Precinct notification. Further details will also be provided to potentially impacted residents in advance of the work. This work is also dependent on weather and site conditons and is subject to change.
