Upcoming out of hours work

Work is progressing well as we create the western station entrance opposite the existing station entrance.

As we continue our work we are required to undertake drainage investigations on the stormwater pit located on the south western corner of John and Bourke streets (see map).

These works will happen out of hours between 6pm Thursday 30 June through to 7am Friday 1 July 2022.

To ensure these works are undertaken safely and to maintain the flow of vehicles along Bourke Street they need to be undertaken out of hours. This will involve the closure of the pedestrian crossing on the corner of John and Bourke streets. Due to the location of the pit, traffic control will be in place for the duration of the work.

What can you expect to see and hear?

The works will require the use of a handheld jack hammer to remove asphalt and concrete for the investigation, a vaccuum excavation truck will also be required.

A compaction plate will then be used to reinstate the area on completion of the work.

We understand that this work will generate noise and inconvenience in the area and we will provide further details to potentially impacted residents in advance of this work.
