Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Medlow Bath Upgrade, between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent.

What work are we doing?

We will be carrying out pavement work at night on Railway Parade from the Great Western Highway to St Albans Road.

As this work interacts with the highway traffic signals at the Railway Parade intersection, we need to undertake the work at night to minimise traffic impacts, ensure safety and improve efficiency.

Nightwork activities will include:

- Milling the road to remove existing pavement
- Asphaltting
- Line marking

When and where we'll be working

We will be working for up to **three nights** on **Monday 13, Tuesday 14 and Thursday 16 November**, weather permitting. Night work hours will be between **6pm and 7am**.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of work activities.

What will this mean for you?

A temporary detour will be in place via Atlingworth Parade and Portland Road during this night work.

We will also have stop/go traffic arrangements in place to manage traffic during the work along Railway Parade opposite the train station.

Residents may notice some noise from machinery and equipment.

There will also be traffic controllers, traffic barriers, equipment, lighting and signage in place during the works.

We will meet with affected residents to discuss individual concerns and ways we can reduce the impact of the works.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Providing a pedestrian pathway along Railway Parade
- Turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages to minimise impacts to nearby residents
- Installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible, to reduce noise
- Maintaining access to properties at all times including the train station.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control will be in place, including detours, stop/slow operations (temporary traffic lights) and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Sections of the road will be closed where necessary to allow work to be carried out safely on Railway Parade.

Road users, including pedestrians and school children, are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
