The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

We will resume utility work along Railway Parade to allow us to complete utility relocation.

What work are we doing?

We will be carrying out utility work front of residences on Railway Parade and across the roadway. This includes the use of an under bore.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working between St Albans Road and Somerset Street from **30 October** for approximately 6 weeks, weather permitting. Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **7am to 1pm, Saturday.**

Protecting street trees


We have redesigned our work on the corner of Sheila Street to preserve the Plane Tree above the Telstra pit. An arborist confirmed that under bore drilling will be deep enough to avoid tree roots.



How will this work impact you?

- There will be a temporary detour in place during the work, but we will maintain property access.
- Some work will be noisy, and we apologise for the inconvenience.
- We will only work during the day and we will minimise noise where possible. Please follow signage and direction of traffic controllers.
