Work on Railway Parade from 5 June

Medlow Bath Upgrade

May 2023

Transport for NSW pays respect to the Wiradjuri, Dharug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade of the Great Western Highway will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work to prepare for the upgrade of the Great Western Highway at Medlow Bath, between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent.

What work are we doing?

Work on Railway Parade includes:

- Earthworks and pavement work to build the new car spaces on Railway Parade near the park and Pot Belly Cafe
- Minor road realignment and construction work
- Detour during a temporary closure on a section of Railway Parade
- Temporary Railway Parade bus stop closure
- Utility relocation and stormwater drainage work
- Installing traffic controls
- Minor vegetation clearing
- Property adjustment work
- Continuation of temporary sediment basin construction
- Landscaping and footpath construction.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working from **Monday 5 June** for around ten weeks.

Working hours will be **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday,** weather permitting. We don't plan any work on Sundays or public holidays.

We have included a map over the page to show the partial closure, detour and location of work.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- A partial closure impacting vehicles and cyclists on Railway Parade, with a detour in place for approximately 10 weeks
- A detour in place for road users off Railway Parade via Atlingworth Parade, Portland Road and St Albans Road
- Maintained access for pedestrians along Railway Parade, to Medlow Park and the railway station
- Access to the Potbelly Café will be maintained and alternative parking will be provided
- Noise from machinery and equipment.
- A temporary closure of the Railway Parade bus stop at the u-turn bay.

We are working with the local bus provider of school bus routes 698 and 8710, and will be providing marshals to assist in moving children safely across the highway or railway while they temporarily use the bus shelters on the Great Western Highway until the bus stop on Railway Parade is reinstated.







Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Closing a section of Railway Parade to allow us to accelerate our program of work
- Turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- Arranging work in stages at different locations.

If there is any way we can support you during these works, please let us know.

We understand that this work will generate some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control, including stop/slow operations, a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h and sections of the road closed will be in place where necessary to allow work to be carried out safely on Railway Parade.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.
