We are approaching completion of construction

Over the past two years, we have been upgrading the Mortdale Maintenance Centre to enable the entire Tangara fleet to be serviced from this location as part of the More Trains, More Services program.


Behind the walls of the maintenance centre, we have:

- Demolished the old maintenance sheds to make room for a new bogie exchange system
- Constructed a new bogie exchange system to facilitate the automatic transfer of bogies
- Widened the driveway off Hurstville Road to enable bogie delivery/collection
- Decommissioned an old substation and installed a new electrical substation

- Reinstated staff parking at the location of the decommissioned substation
- Civil work to support the above-mentioned activities, including track modification, drainage work and new retaining walls
- Associated electrical and lighting work.

A train bogie is a mechanical element that comprises of a set of 4 train wheels, suspensions, and brakes on a frame. The Bogie Exchange System will enable the bogies to be mechanically transferred between buildings and facility levels, improving the maintenance capabilities of the centre.

What work is left?

With only minor activities remaining at the Mortdale Maintenance Centre, we're expecting to demobilise in August 2022. In the coming weeks, we will be:

- Completing the fit-out and commissioning the new Bogie Exchange System
- Completing construction of the new access road
- Finalising electrical activities required to commission the new substation
- Re-commissioning a rail loop road adjacent to the maintenance building.

Upcoming night work

The project has achieved a number of milestones in recent months and in preparation for construction completion, some weekend work will be required between July and August 2022.

This work has been scheduled to take place between:

- Friday 29 July and Monday 1 August
- Friday 19 and Monday 22 August.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours on this project are **7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 8am-1pm on Saturdays**.
