



Upcoming night work

As part of the More Trains, More Services work on the Mortdale Maintenance Centre Upgrade, we are required to complete some substation and electrical activities outside of standard construction hours (7am-6pm) in the coming months.

This work has been scheduled to take place during power isolation periods, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

These activities will take place inside the walls of the maintenance centre are not expected to impact the local community.

Work is scheduled to be carried out from:

- **6pm Monday 1 November until 7am Tuesday 2 November 2021**
- **6pm Friday 5 November until 11pm Sunday 7 November 2021**
- **6pm Saturday 20 November until 7am Monday 22 November 2021**
- **6pm Saturday 11 December until 7am Monday 13 December 2021**

Minimising impacts

The project team understands that construction activities may cause disruption for the community and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts to the surrounding community
- installing noise barriers to shield residents from high impact noise activities
- conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
