



Two more landslip sites repaired near Cambewarra Mountain

Natural disaster recovery on Moss Vale Road

June 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wodi Wodi people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport is working to repair landslip damage that will make Moss Vale Road more resilient to impacts of future severe weather events.

Work has been completed at two more landslip damage sites on Moss Vale Road near Cambewarra Mountain.

What we have achieved

The work has stabilised the slope above the road at both sites.

Key components of the repairs were:

- soil nails and rock bolts that add strength across the slope
- a durable layer of Geomesh
- spray-on concrete mix known as “shotcrete”.

Repair site facts

Transport engaged contractors with specialist experience working on steep slope sites to carry out the work.

The contractors used a long-reach excavator and elevated work platform to complete work on the steep slopes.

There is a lot that goes into – and comes out of – repairing landslip damage on a road. We have:

- removed nine cubic metres of loose material
- installed 40 soil nails and 17 rock bolts
- laid 36 square metres of Geomesh mat
- applied 20 cubic metres of shotcrete.



A long-reach excavator was used to remove loose material and drill the soil nails, while workers accessed the steep slope from an elevated work platform (inset) to complete tasks like applying shotcrete.





Transport worked with the contractors and traffic controllers to make sure work was completed as quickly as possible while keeping traffic moving past the site as smoothly as possible.

Work site safety

Transport thanks the community and motorists for their patience while this work was carried out.

We worked closely with the construction contractors and traffic controllers to make sure the work was carried out safely while traffic kept flowing through the site.

Transport reminds everyone that the reduced speed limits at work sites are necessary to keep both workers and motorists safe.
