Mount Colah Station Footbridge renewal works

From Tuesday 11 July to Monday 31 July 2023

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the existing footbridge at Mount Colah Station. As part of the project, new platform lifts will be constructed on the platform and eastern and western sides of the station.

Upcoming works

To prepare for the construction of a new pedestrian footbridge and lifts, the following activities will occur within the rail corridor, adjacent to Pierre Close, Mount Colah from Tuesday 11 July to Monday 31 July:

- excavation of lift and stair footings
- lift and stair footing concreting
- installation of new services route.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise.
- Works will take place from:
 - **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**
 - **8am to 1pm on Saturdays.**
- Power tools and machinery will be used throughout works, we will select low-noise equipment when available.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.
