## Day and Night work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road 13 February 2023 to 3 April 2023

**Transport for NSW is delivering the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. A contractor has been appointed and is currently preparing to start construction.**

As previously notified, to progress construction, investigation work will be carried out over the period from **13 February 2023 to 3 April 2023** on Mulgoa Road and surrounding streets between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. Due to high traffic volumes on Mulgoa Road, in order to maintain access to businesses and residents and for the safety of our workers and road users, some of this work needs to be done at night.

The location of the work is shown in the map over the page.

### Traffic changes

Temporary day and night-time lane closures will be in place on Mulgoa Road and side streets and road users will need to follow instructions of traffic controllers and use available lanes of traffic. Access to side streets, businesses and residences will be available at all times.

### Date and time of work

**Dates:** Monday 13 February 2023 till Monday 3 April 2023

#### Day times

Between 7am and 6pm on local roads

Between 10am to 2pm on Mulgoa Road

#### Night times:

Between 9pm and 5am Monday to Wednesday nights

Between 10pm and 5am Thursday and Friday nights

Between 9pm and 6am Sunday nights.

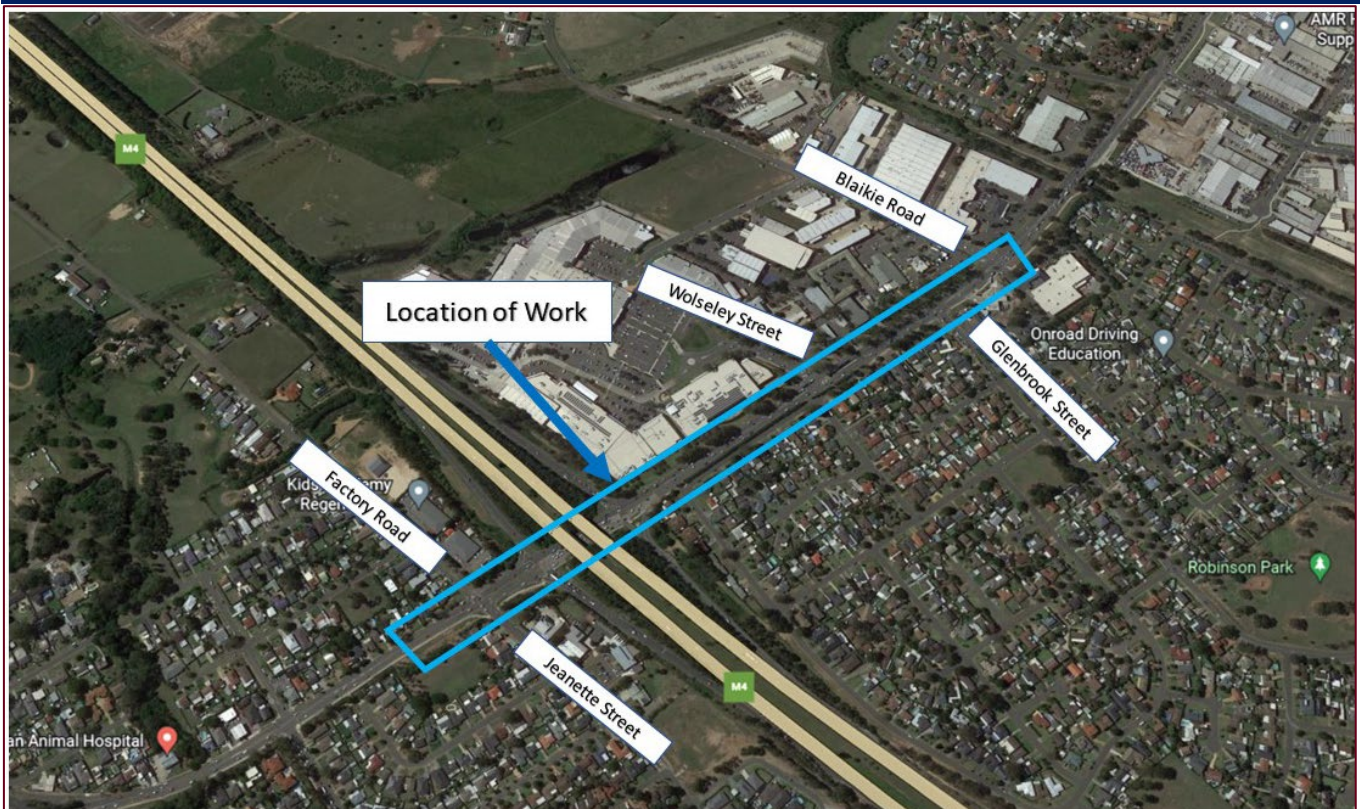
## What are we doing?

The work over this period will include pavement coring, survey, concrete cutting, pavement and footpath reinstatement and potholing to locate subsurface utilities. The plant and machinery used will be a corer truck, small excavator, concrete saw, concrete truck, tipper, roller, jet blaster and vacuum truck, small saws and generators and lighting towers.

There will be some noise associated with this work, and we will try and minimise this by scheduling noisy activities earlier at night and during the day as far as possible. We will also schedule work in any one area for only two nights in a row.

If you are likely to be impacted by excessive noise, we will inform you in advance.
