Work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road 3 April 2023 till 15 May 2023

Transport for NSW is delivering the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. Work has progressed on utility investigations on Mulgoa and surrounding roads.

To progress construction, work will continue over the period of **3 April 2023 to 15 May 2023** on Mulgoa Road and surrounding streets between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road (see map overleaf).

We will be doing work to set up our site compound, remove vegetation, conduct utility investigations, remove the median in the road, secure our project boundary and put barriers on the road, behind which we will work during the day.

Traffic changes

Temporary day time lane closures will be in place on Mulgoa Road and side streets and road users will need to follow instructions of traffic controllers and use available lanes of traffic. Access to side streets, businesses and residences will be available at all times.

Date and time of work

Dates: Monday 3 April 2023 till Monday 15 May 2023

Day times


Between 7am and 6pm on local roads Between 10am to 2pm on Mulgoa Road

What are we doing?

The work over this period will include vegetation removal supervised by an ecologist and arborist. Seed collection from the vegetation and transport of the removed vegetation for reuse to another site.

We are setting up our site compound at a site just south of the M4 Motorway at 111 Mulgoa Road and work will progress on this. We will also be demolishing and removing the existing concrete median and replacing it with a temporary road surface. We will then start securing our project boundary with barriers and fencing so we can work adjacent to the road during the day behind safety barriers. This work will be to relocate utilities for the upgrade.
