NAME THE CRANE COLOURING COMPETITION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By entering the Name the Crane and Colouring Competition (the Competition), an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

2. The purpose of the Competition is to name the tower crane on the New Dubbo Bridge Project. Children of parents employed on the New Dubbo Bridge are eligible to enter the Competition.

3. The Competition is being run by Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure.

4. The Competition closes 5pm, 31 August 2023. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.

5. Winners of the Competition will be notified by telephone or email within 28 days of the closing date.

6. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.

8. To enter the Competition, entrants must suggest a name for the crane and colour in the drawing on the entry form, and complete their details including name, age and school

10. Each entrant may only enter the Competition once. Multiple entries from the

same person will be disqualified.

11. Prizes include the opportunity to name the tower crane on the New Dubbo Bridge Project, have that name displayed on the crane, attend the official crane naming ceremony, and receive a special prize.

12. The prizes are as follows:

a. **BEST CRANE NAME**: The selected name will be showcased using a flag on the crane, and the overall winner for the best crane name will receive a \$200 book or sporting goods voucher for their school.

b. **TOP COLOURING-IN SUBMISSION:** The top colouring submissions will be awarded the following prizes across four categories:

K-2 Winner \$100 book or sporting goods voucher

K- 2 Runner-up \$50 book or sporting goods voucher

3-6 Winner \$100 book or sporting goods voucher

3-6 Runner-up \$50 book or sporting goods voucher

A diverse selection of student entries will be displayed at the New Dubbo Bridge Office (4/36 Darling Street, Dubbo), and the winner of the naming contest will receive an invitation to attend a cranenaming ceremony, with the specific date yet to be announced.

13. The entry must be the entrant's own original work and has not been copied from any other work.

14. Each entry is the property of Abergeldie, and it has no obligation to return any entry to an entrant.

15. Judging will be conducted by a 3-member panel including representatives of Transport for NSW Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure and a local government representative.

16. Entries will be judged on the creativity of the crane name and artistic merit given the child's age. The judging panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

17. Entries which are incomplete, inappropriate, offensive, non-serious or incomprehensible will be ruled ineligible.

18. Any personal data relating to winners, or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998 and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.

19. The winner consents to the announcement and promotion (including photographs and/or filming) of the winning entrants name, school and age, and publication of the winning entry in all media channels, including social media.

20. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this Competition.

21. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
