



Preparation work to commence on the New Dubbo Bridge, from Thursday 1 December 2022

Together, the Australian Government and the NSW Government are jointly funding the \$220.2 million New Dubbo Bridge project to reduce traffic congestion in Dubbo and enhance access across the Macquarie River during flood events.

Head Contractor, Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure, will commence preparation works on the New Dubbo Bridge project in December 2022 in locations marked on the map below.



Work in the project area

Work will take place in various areas across the project site and will commence in December 2022 and continue into the start of 2023.

The work will include:

- Site establishment work
- Establishing site compounds
- Installation of fencing and traffic barriers
- Establishing environmental controls
- Investigation works
- Access road and piling pad work.

Early work already underway to realign and reconstruct the northern end of Darling Street between Evans Street and River Street will continue. Darling Street will continue to be closed in this area, with a detour in place. This work is expected to be complete in February 2023.

How will the work affect you?

Our standard work hours will be **Monday to Sunday from 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday between 8am and 1pm**. There is no planned work on Sunday and public holidays. Night work may be required.

Equipment used for investigation work includes light construction vehicles, survey equipment, borehole truck, non-destructive excavation trucks.

All sites will have 24-hour solar powered security cameras, we will also have security guard surveillance monitoring the project area outside working hours.

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work to ensure that work zones are safe. This may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Construction during Christmas, New Year and Australia Day

Christmas and New Year: construction sites will close over the Christmas and New Year holiday period from **6pm Thursday 22 December 2022** until **7am Monday 9 January 2023**.

Australia Day: construction sites will be closed for the Australia Day public holiday from **6pm Wednesday 25 January** until **7am Friday 27 January 2023**.

While constructions sites are closed, surveillance and periodic checks will take place to ensure the site is secure and maintained.
