Transport for NSW is carrying out essential work on the Newell Highway Upgrade, New Dubbo Bridge project.

As part of our construction program, we will be relocating and installing utilities on River Street between Bourke and Darling Street. This includes relocating and replacing high voltage power poles.

To enable this work, there will be a power outage required along River Street on Sunday 12 November from 8am – 5pm.

When and where we'll be working

As part of the works, our crews will be relocating and installing utilities underground.

This work will take place on River Street, between Bourke and Darling Street.

To minimise impacts, we will undertake this work within one day on **Sunday 12 November**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between **8am and 5pm** in line with the planned power outage.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of work activities.

How will you be notified?

Under the National Electricity Customer Framework (NECF), Essential Energy is required to provide customers with a **minimum of four business days' prior notice of planned power outages** to enable them to make alternative arrangements, if necessary.

If you are impacted by the power outage you should have already been advised of the date and time of the power outage via Essential Energy's standard outage notification process. A reminder will also be sent closer to the outage date.

Residents and businesses are encouraged to make alternative arrangements if power is required during the period of a planned power outage.

Customers who rely on a continuous power supply to operate medical equipment should plan ahead and contact us to discuss your needs.
