Temporary closure of the Golden Highway for night work on the New England Highway upgrade from Monday 6 November

The NSW Government is investing \$97 million for the upgrade of the New England Highway between Belford and the Golden Highway to improve traffic flow, travel times and safety for motorists.

Transport for NSW has engaged ACCIONA to deliver the upgrade. Night work will be carried out to complete asphalt work on the eastbound alignments of the New England Highway and Golden Highway.

We will be working at night from **8pm** on **Monday 6 November** to **4am** on **Friday 24 November** and expect to complete the work in approximately **15 shifts**, weather permitting. No work will be carried out on Saturday and Sunday.

Traffic changes

This work requires temporary night closures of the Golden Highway from 8pm on Monday 6 November to 4am on Friday 24 November (excluding Saturday and Sunday nights). A detour will be in place from 8pm each night to 4am the following morning.

Motorists will be detoured via Range Road and the New England Highway. We have included a map to show the alternate route.

Motorists are advised to plan ahead as the detour is expected to add up to 10 minutes of extra travel time.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which produces some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when they are not in use. During the temporary closure, residents along the detour route may experience an increase in traffic noise.
