The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

Two rail infrastructure upgrade projects are currently being delivered in your area as part of this program, including:

- DC Feeder Power Supply Upgrade project
- Newtown to Redfern Signalling Upgrade project.

What work are we doing?

In April and May we'll carry out the following work inside the rail corridor:

- investigation work using a vacuum truck
- ground reinforcement work to strengthen existing rail infrastructure

You may also notice out-of-hours deliveries of materials and equipment to our work area and compound. The majority of deliveries will be scheduled during the day, however some deliveries will be required at night during a scheduled trackwork period.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

Work will take place inside the rail corridor as shown overleaf. The site compound located on Gladstone Street between Phillip Street and Station Street will be used for storage of equipment and materials, worker parking and pre-start work meetings.

Out-of-hours work and deliveries

Some work will take place outside of standard construction hours from **10pm Friday 28 April through to 5am Monday 1 May 2023**.

Out-of-hours work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables us to complete the work safely.

In connection to the work, there may be several out-of-hours deliveries made to the site compound via the access point on Station Street **from Thursday 27 April through to Monday 1 May 2023**.

All construction work is weather permitting and subject to change.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and heavy vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community.

We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
