

Night work on the North West T-way for pavement repair from 22 May





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is funding a new bus layover facility at Blacktown as part of the Bus Priority Infrastructure Program, which aims to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion for all road users.

What work are we doing?

We will carry out the following works:

- patch repair to the concrete pavement opposite Third Ave
- removal of the existing asphalt pavement and re-surfacing of the T-way road pavement

Our work schedule

Out-of-hours work will take place between **Sunday 22 May and Friday 30 June.**

The concrete pavement patching works are scheduled to occur over four nights between Sunday 22 May and Friday 3 June, subject to weather conditions. The asphalt resurfacing works are scheduled to occur over four consecutive nights between Sunday 19 June and Friday 30 June, subject to weather conditions.

Our normal construction work hours are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 7am to 1pm.

Out-of-hours work hours will be from Sunday to Friday from 7pm to 5am. Noisy work will be carried out between 7pm and 11pm.

Traffic changes

There will be a road closure on the T-Way to ensure the work zone is safe. Buses will be detoured via Sackville/Peter/Gordon Streets during the works.

Bus services will remain unaffected during the works with minor timetable changes.

Access for residents, pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles will always be maintained.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance. This includes:

- turning off equipment when not in use
- completing noisy work by 11 PM
- using noise blankets
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill


Location of work area



Did you know?

The project will implement a greening strategy to reduce much warmer temperatures experienced due to urban surfaces such as roadways and rooftops which absorb and retain heat. We will plant 56 trees to replace the five trees removed during construction and plant over 6000 shrubs and ground cover plants.
