Nightworks on the Castlereagh Highway at Lidsdale from Sunday 9 July

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on the Castlereagh Highway at Lidsdale, approximately fifteen kilometres NORTH of Lithgow

The work includes asphalting to provide an improved road surface between Springvale Lane and Skelly Road in Lidsdale. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working between **7pm** and **6am** from **Sunday 9 July** and expected to complete the work in **two weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of motorists and our workers, work will be taking place at night. The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise completing nosier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Outside of work hours speed limits will return to posted speed limit. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work


