

Normanhurst Station Upgrade

Community notification - February 2023

The Normanhurst Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

What's next at Normanhurst?

During February we will be working on:

- continuing fit-out of new lifts
- continuing installing communication cables
- installing new public address system (PA speakers)
- installing canopies on the station platforms
- landscaping work on Malsbury Road
- excavating and trenching on Denman Parade and Normanhurst Road to install new power cables.

Our standard schedule work hours remain as **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**.

Temporary lane closure

From **Wednesday 1 February until late February**, a temporary lane closure will be in place at **Denman Parade and Normanhurst Road** to allow for the excavating and trenching work to be carried out. This work is required to provide additional power to the lifts.

During this period, a stop/slow traffic arrangement will be in place, including traffic control and signage to assist motorists.

Temporary footpath closure

The footpath on Denman Parade and Normanhurst Road will be also temporarily closed from **Wednesday 1 February until late**

February as part of the excavating and trenching work.

During this period, a temporary detour will be implemented for all pedestrians.

How this work may impact you

We will be using a range of equipment throughout February which includes excavators, jackhammers, compactors, trucks, grinders and various hand and power tools.

Our work will be noisy at times. Where possible measures will be implemented to reduce noise including turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties, use of noise blanket and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Changes to scheduled work

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be significant changes to the construction program.
