The NSW Government is upgrading 3.6 kilometres of Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future traffic demands on this corridor.

When and where we'll be working

From 8pm Wednesday 30 August to 6pm Friday 15 September, we will be closing the Ponds Road and Prospect Highway intersection and the Great Western Highway westbound off ramp. This closure will allow us to work safely.

What work are we doing?

This work will involve drainage work, excavation, placement of material, pavement construction, kerb and gutter installation, line marking and barrier installation.

Our work schedule

During this period, our work hours will be:

- Day: Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm
- Night: Sunday to Thursday 8pm to 5am

What will this mean for you?

The night work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, completing noisier work earlier in the evening and turning off vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

To complete works Ponds Road and Prospect Highway intersection and the Great Western Highway westbound off ramp will be temporarily closed between Wednesday 30 August and Friday 15 September.

Detours:

During this time detours will be in place via Reservoir Road and M4 Motorway for traffic accessing Prospect Highway to and from Ponds Road. This will add an extra two-minute travel time.

Cyclists will have to detour via Flushcombe Road and Myrtle Street which takes approximately 20 minutes.

Access to the church and cemetery will remain. Traffic control will be onsite to always let anyone for the church or cemetery through.

Electronic message signs will be activated. Traffic control will be in place during work hours for the safety of workers and road users.

Motorists should follow signs and the traffic controller's direction and allow extra time as there may be minor delays. Please refer to the maps below for the detour information.
