


Mona Vale Road East upgrade

Traffic switch on Mona Vale Road September 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Garigal and Caregal people of the Guringai Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mona Vale Road between Manor Road, Ingleside and Foley Street, Mona Vale, from two lanes to four lanes to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety.

Traffic switch

in the September construction update we advised the community that work was continuing on the new westbound lanes and median islands between Daydream Street and Foley Street in the September construction update.

As work progresses, we will carry out a traffic switch from Tuesday 26 September 2023, over two nights from 8pm to 6am, weather permitting, with a contingency of three further nights, dependent on weather. Should there be adverse weather or site conditions this work will be rescheduled. Variable Messaging Signs (VMS) will advise of any changes.

This traffic switch will involve diverting traffic onto the newly constructed eastbound road pavement.

The existing roundabout at the intersection of Mona Vale Road, Samuel Street and Ponderosa Parade will be shifted closer to Samuel Street.

Our working hours

To minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to workers and road users, we need to complete this work at night.

Night shift hours for this work will be between 8pm to 6am on Tuesday 26 September and 8pm to 6am Wednesday 27 September, with a contingency of three further nights, dependent on weather.

Bus stop relocation

This work requires changes to pedestrian access. Pedestrians will now use the new footpath constructed on the eastern side from Daydream to Emma Street, with the current Mona Vale Road pedestrian crossing shifted north to align with the new roundabout location.

The existing bus stop on the eastbound side of Mona Vale Road (Stop ID 210395) will be moved to its permanent location east of Samuel Street (see location on map).

How will our work affect you?

During this night work machinery and equipment used may include a big crane, large trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers. This work will be noisy.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by turning machinery and vehicles off when not in use and directing lighting away from properties, where possible.

Managing our impacts

Concrete barriers, signage and line markings will be in place to guide road users through the new road alignment and roundabout.

Any directly impacted residents will be individually contacted in advance of the work.

On the evening of the night shifts, to help road users navigate the traffic changes, there will be signage, VMS and traffic controllers in place. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
