I refer to your submission received on 21 December 2022, requesting the determination of the scope of work detailed in Hollywood Shanty Town Site and the Wallsend/Plattsburg Tramway Archaeological Salvage (rev 4, November 2022) (the LIW Submission) as Low Impact Work and not Construction.

I note the scope of work detailed in the LIW Submission:

- has been prepared in consultation with DPE Biodiversity and Conservation Division and DPE Heritage NSW, and neither opposed the scope of work being categorised as Low Impact Work;
- involves the salvage of 10-12 demolished structures within the approved construction footprint
- requires clearing 3.8 hectares of the 4.1 hectares of PCT HU806 'Spotted Gum Red Ironbark
 Grey Gum shrub grass open forest of the Lower Hunter' already approved to be cleared
- will be undertaken for 6-8 weeks during standard construction hours.

The Department has carefully reviewed the LIW and is satisfied that it is suitable for a determination as Low Impact Work under the SSI-6888 Project Approval's definition of Construction.
