Upcoming work notification

January 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

When we will work

8 January to 31 January 2024,
Monday to Friday, between 7am and 6pm

During this time, our team will complete road, utility and finishing work on Lawson, Ivy, Wilson and Little Eveleigh streets.

On Lawson Street near the Little Eveleigh Street intersection, work will include line marking, as well as light pole, signage and tactile marker installation.

Mid-week night work

- 10pm Wednesday 10, to 6am Thursday 11 January
- 10pm Thursday 11, to 6am Friday 12 January.

After the last train service on the evenings above, subject to approval, our team will complete work on the Platform 10 canopy.

While workers will set-up from 10pm, for the safety of our workers and train passengers, the main work will be completed when trains are not running (between 1am and 4am approx.).

Weekend work

- 6pm Friday 19 to 6am Monday 22 January 2024

During this weekend, roadwork and resurfacing will be done at Lawson Street, near the intersection of Little Eveleigh Street (subject to further approvals)

What work will be done in January?

- Roadwork, including resurfacing road surfaces
- Installing light poles, signposts and signs
- Canopy and awning work
- Installing street furniture
- Installing a traffic island
- Line marking
- Landscaping

What does this mean for you?

While the work is underway, you may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Noise and vibration from machinery and equipment, such as grinders, jackhammers, power saws, rattle guns, rock hammers/breakers, rollers, asphalt trucks, whacker-packers, excavators and vacuum trucks.

Traffic and parking impacts

Either a single westbound or eastbound lane closure on Lawson Street will be in place, which may cause minor traffic delays.

Traffic control and signage will assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians.

There may also be a temporary loss of parking space while the work occurs.

Managing our impacts

We reduce noise and vibration by turning off machinery when not in use and, where possible, use noise absorbing blankets.




