What's happening in April?

In April, we'll continue work on the New Southern Concourse, new station entrances and shared zones in Little Eveleigh and Marian streets. This work includes:

- Installing scaffolding and steel
- Fitting out lifts, stairs, bridges and platforms
- Roofing across bridge and platform canopies
- Tiling, painting and cladding installation
- Electrical, stormwater and other utility work
- Excavating, backfilling and concreting
- Installing kerbs, drains, bollards and pavers
- Landscaping including tree removal and planting
- Platform resurfacing and tactile installation.

When and where we'll be working

Our standard work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday.**

For the safety of our team, some of our work needs to take place outside the standard hours to coincide with Sydney Trains trackwork, when trains don't run.

In April, we will work on the following weekends:

- **8pm Thursday 6 to 5am Tuesday 11 April**
(Easter long weekend)
Platform 10 pedestrian access will be closed from 2am Friday 7 to 2am Tuesday 11 April
- **8pm Friday 14 to 5am Monday 17 April**
Platform 10 pedestrian access will be closed from 11pm Friday 14 to 2am Monday 17 April
- **8pm Friday 21 to 5am Monday 24 April**
- **2am Saturday 29 April to 2am Monday 1 May**

Lawson street utility works

During the Easter long weekend, service investigation, excavation and stormwater installation will occur at the corner of Little Eveleigh and Lawson Streets. This work may also extend across the other weekends in April.

A single lane closure westbound on Lawson Street will be in place, which may cause minor traffic delays. Traffic control and signage will assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians.

What this means for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Noise and vibration from machinery and equipment, such as: grinders; jackhammers, power saws, rattle guns, rock hammers / breakers, rollers and vacuum trucks.

Managing our impacts

We reduce noise and vibration by turning off machinery when not in use, and where possible, using noise absorbing blankets.

Location of work area

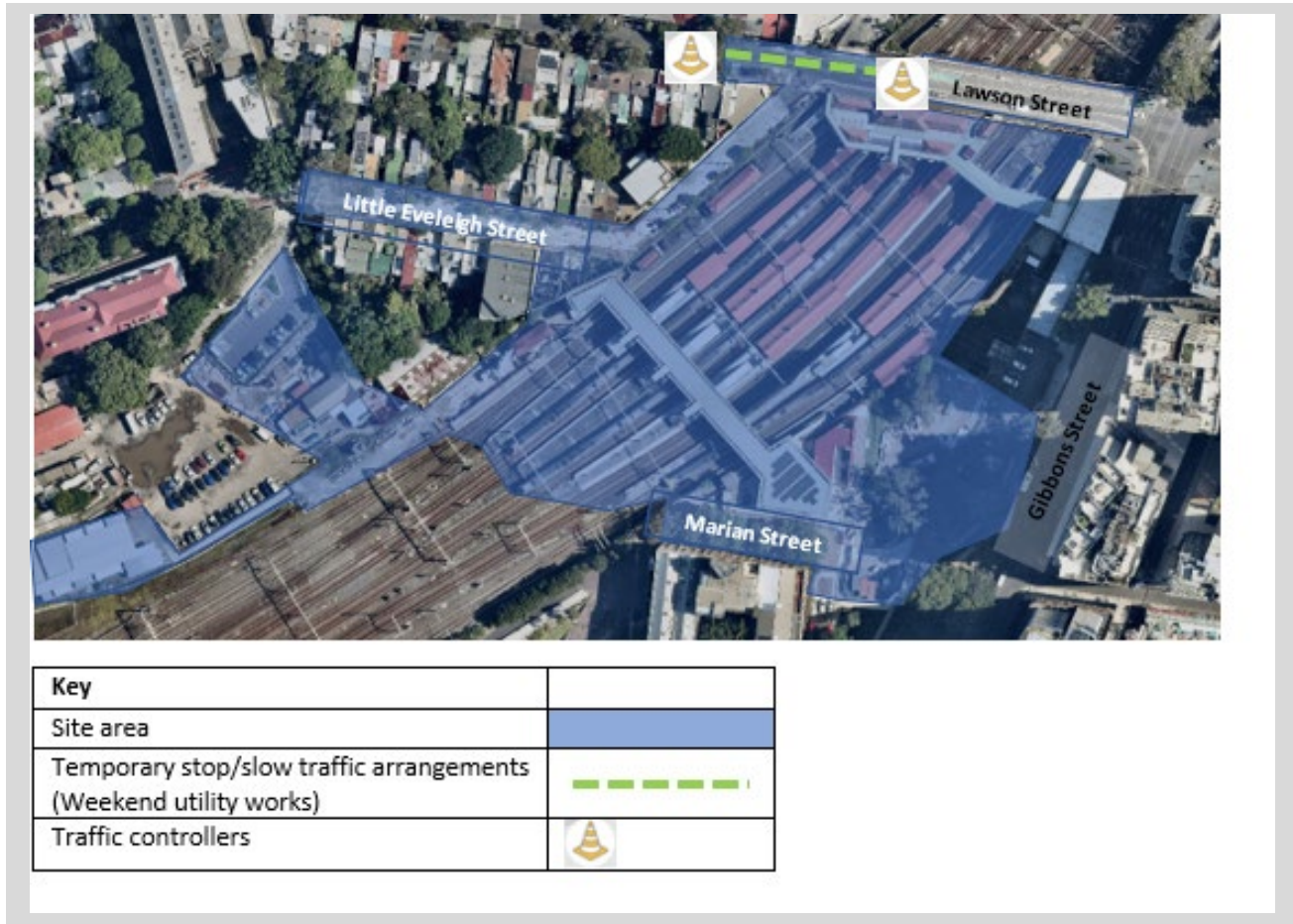


Figure 1. Map above shows the current Redfern Station Upgrade work area
