What's happening in September?

In September, we'll continue to work on the New Southern Concourse, new station entrances and shared zones in Little Eveleigh and Marian streets and related works on Lawson, Wilson and Ivy streets. Our work includes:

- Installing scaffolding and steel
- Fitting out lifts, stairs, bridges, platforms and buildings
- Roofing across the bridge and platform canopies
- Tiling, painting and cladding installation
- Demolition, material removal and deliveries
- Electrical, stormwater and other utility work
- Excavating, backfilling and concreting
- Installing kerbs, drains, bollards and pavers
- Road line marking
- Installing wayfinding signage
- Installing kiss and ride spaces on Lawson Street
- Landscaping including tree pruning and planting
- Platform resurfacing and tactile installation
- Testing and commissioning services
- Investigative works
- Heritage building works.

When and where we'll work

Our standard construction hours are:

7am-6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am-6pm Saturday.

Some of our work will also take place outside standard hours - to coincide with Sydney Trains trackwork - when trains don't run and it's safe for our team to work on or near the tracks.

In September, we will work on the following weekend:

• 10pm Friday 8 to 6am Monday 11 September.

The Platform 10 pedestrian access will also be closed during this trackwork weekend.

7am-6pm, Monday 4 September, Ivy Street and access to Little Eveleigh Street from Lawson Street will be closed for a day to motor vehicles to allow for line marking. **Tuesday 5 and Friday 8 September** are contingencies for wet weather.

Electrical work, testing and commissioning and painting may also occur up to three nights per week, however these activities are not expected to be noisy.

For the safety of road users, materials and equipment may also be delivered or removed outside standard construction hours during September.

What this might mean for you?

During September you may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Noise and vibration from machinery and equipment, such as grinders, jackhammers, power saws, rattle guns, rock hammers/breakers, rollers and vacuum trucks.

Managing our impacts

We reduce noise and vibration by turning machinery off when it's not in use and, where possible, using noise absorbing blankets.
