### What is the RMCC?



## RMCC is:

Transport's contract that enables Councils to undertake works on State Roads.

This comes with a number of specifications and conditions:

- WHS, Environment and Quality Management Systems
- G22 Clause is a TfNSW specification for WHS
- RMCC also requires a R2 prequalification

- develop a risk-based approach to monitoring and verification activities through ongoing surveillance



# Management of Works



# Management of Works:

### **Prior to works commencing:**

- check project specific management plans
- site specific risks and controls
- hold points released

### **TfNSW surveillance management plans:**

- risk based approach to surveillance
- surveillance based on site activities and risks involved

### Site surveillance

- principally using Surveillance Officers
- surveillance will focus on management systems, Traffic Control at Worksites Manual, and Separation of People and Plant.
- Verification of work and system implementation
