Transport for NSW is delivering the Riverwood Commuter Car Park to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and help ease congestion on our roads.

What's planned?

The Riverwood Commuter Car Park on Webb Street will feature:

- A new multi-storey commuter car park with up to 140 parking spaces
- Entry and exit to the car park from Webb Street
- Additional accessible parking spaces
- Provision for future electric vehicle charging spaces
- Transport Park&Ride infrastructure (Opal operated boom gates)
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signs for improved safety and security
- · Landscaping.

Upcoming construction work

Construction on the Riverwood Commuter Car Park is progressing well. From February to April 2023, construction activities include:

- Concreting, including lift shaft, suspended slabs, columns, and stairs
- Installation of scaffolding
- Installation of external façade
- Services installation
- Electrical works, with minor pedestrian detours on Webb Street
- Formwork activities.

The equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, excavators, surveying equipment, mobile cranes, concrete pumps, concrete agitators, elevated work platforms and hand tools.

Our work Schedule

We will be on site from **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 6pm** and between **8am and 1pm** on **Saturdays.**

At times throughout February and March, there may be instances where concrete finishing works may run late, and workers may be required to be on site from **6pm to 10pm, Monday to Friday**, due to the time sensitivity of concrete works.

Powered hand tools for concrete finishing work may be in use.

We will contact you to advise of any work required outside of these hours.

Our work may be noisy at times and we have put measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used onsite.
