

Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

Community notification

May/June 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering the Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path linking Sutherland to Cronulla. Stage 2 East construction is underway between Jackson Avenue, Miranda and Gannons Road, Caringbah.

What work are we doing in May/June?

Work planned for May/June includes:

- temporary parking removal (in sections) along Malvern Road reserve (including boats and trailers)
- signage and line marking changes
- clearance of vegetation like turf and shrubs
- installation of erosion and sediment controls
- continue excavation and construction of cycleway.
- minor tree trimming and removal, subject to approval.

We are continuing to investigate the retention of trees on Denman Avenue, Caringbah and will keep the community informed.

The section of SCATL Stage 2 East where we are working is Kingsway between Miranda Road and Carramar Crescent, Miranda.

When we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.** We will notify nearby residents and

businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, dump truck, concrete trucks and pumps, working trucks, mulcher, vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, power tools and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place for changes to access and parking
- temporary fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers

We will work with nearby residents and provide notification ahead of work in the area.

Future temporary driveway closures

As part of our construction work, there will be temporary changes to driveway access. We will be rolling out both a business and resident survey in the coming months to understand the best days and times of the week to temporarily close a driveway or footpath to enable safe construction work.

Initiatives during construction

We are looking for not-for-profit and/or local community organisations who have innovative ideas for the recycling and reuse of timber and mulch.
