



# Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

## Night work and traffic changes notification

December 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering the Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL), a pedestrian and bicycle path linking Sutherland to Cronulla.

### Night time work

Transport for NSW will carry out night work from **8pm to 5am on Tuesday 12 December**, weather permitting, to **close the right turn from Kingsway (westbound) to Banksia Road, Caringbah**.

To create a safe work area, we are required to work at night when there is less impact to traffic flow.

Work at night includes the following activities:

- Site set up including temporary lane closures
- Concreting at the median island
- Adjustments to line marking and signage.

### What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment including concrete trucks, working trucks, mobile lighting towers, power tools and hand tools. We will cease noisiest work activities at midnight.

### Traffic changes during night works

Temporary traffic changes and lane closures will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe during night work.

Motorists are asked to take extra care, keep to displayed speed limits and observe traffic controls and signage when travelling through work areas.

### No right turn at Banksia Road

From **5am on Wednesday 13 December** there will be **no right turn** from Kingsway (westbound) to Banksia Road.

To access Banksia Road the alternative route for motorists is:

- Right turn at Willarong Road
- Then right turn at Dianella Street
- Then right turn at either Sunnyside Avenue or Cawarra Road.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and allow for extra travel time.

### Willarong Road intersection traffic signals

Construction work is currently underway to install new traffic signals at the intersection of Willarong Road and Kingsway.

The new traffic signals are expected to be completed in the first half of 2024.
