

Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

Community notification

November 2023 – Willarong Road night work extended.



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient and enjoyable transport option.

Extended working hours approved with ongoing monitoring

During September we asked residents and businesses within 100m of the intersection of Willarong Road and Kingsway, Caringbah for feedback on our proposal to extend night time working days, which would allow us to complete the intersection upgrade around four months earlier than originally planned.

Transport for NSW reviewed the feedback received during this consultation period and based on the community feedback received, has approved work up to five nights a week.

The approval to work up to five nights a week is subject to ongoing review and compliance checks.

What work are we doing?

Day time work

As mentioned in the October/November community notification, from **Monday 30 October**, our day work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, weather permitting as we continue work at Willarong Road/Kingsway intersection.

Work planned includes:

- continued excavation and construction of active transport link
- temporary closure of driveways for construction work, as required
- landscaping works, new signage and line marking.

Night time work

From **Sunday 5 November**, our night work hours will be between **6pm and 5am, up to five nights a week**, weather permitting.

We are continuing construction at the **Willarong Road/Kingsway intersection**.

Work planned includes:

- relocation of underground and aboveground services like power and telecommunications
- construction of new traffic signals
- upgrading kerb and gutter, pram ramps and footpath
- temporary closure of driveways for construction work, as required
- re-asphalting of the intersection
- landscaping works, new signage and line marking.

What will this mean for you?

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- completing the noisiest work activities (e.g saw cutting, jack hammering) before midnight
- traffic controllers operating and changed traffic conditions during working hours
- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

We will be using a range of equipment including sucker trucks, excavators, dump trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, mill machines, asphaltting machines, delivery trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

Parking changes

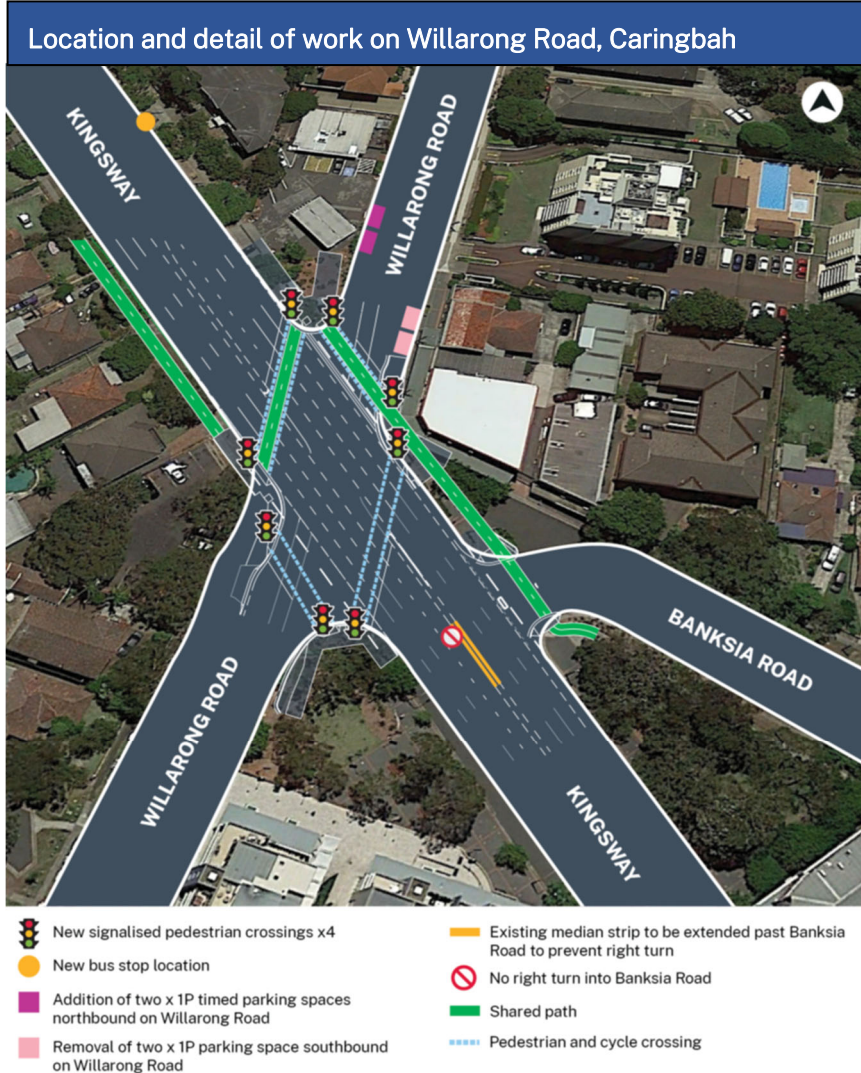
Some minor parking changes will be required on Kingsway and Willarong Road to enable safe construction activities.

All parking will be returned once construction is complete. Signs will be in place in advance to advise of temporary changes.
