


Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

Community notification

December/January 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient and enjoyable transport option.

What work are we doing?

Day time work

Our day work hours are **7am to 6pm**, **Monday to Friday**. We are continuing construction at the following locations:

Work at **Denman Avenue from Gannons Road to Banksia Road** includes:

- temporary lane changes to enable construction works
- continued excavation and construction of active transport link (west of Nullaburra Road)
- continued removal of trees and trimming of overhead branches, as approved
- landscaping, new signage and line marking.

Work at **Kingsway from Hinkler Avenue to Kareena Road (near Sutherland Hospital)** includes landscaping works, new signage and line marking.

Night time work

Our night work hours will be from **6pm to 5am**, **Sunday to Friday**. We are continuing/commencing construction at the following locations and as shown on the maps overleaf:

- Kingsway from Willarong Road to Taren Point Road and Hinkler Avenue to Kareena Road.
- Kingsway/Willarong Road intersection
- Kingsway/Taren Point Road intersection
- Gannons Road/Denman Avenue intersection.

What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, sucker trucks, dump trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, asphalters, delivery trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place for changes
- temporary fencing for safety and security
- traffic controllers operating
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use.

We will contact nearby residents and businesses and provide notification ahead of work in the area.


Temporary driveway closures

We will work closely with residents where temporary driveway closures are required to carry out construction. Access will be maintained outside our working hours or as arranged with residents and construction requirements.

Temporary pedestrian detour and bus stop relocation

- A temporary pedestrian detour and bus stop relocation is in place until late-December at Kingsway (westbound) near Sutherland Hospital while construction work is underway.
 Please follow signs in place to assist.
- The bus stop on Denman Avenue, Caringbah (westbound) has been relocated 80 metres west Denman Avenue and is now open for use.
