



# Sefton Park Infrastructure Upgrade

## More Trains, More Services

November 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The More Trains, More Services program is simplifying and modernising the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

### What work are we doing?

In November 2023, work includes:

- investigation activities, including site walks and scanning for underground services
- signalling investigation and installation work
- installation of underground cable routes
- track modifications
- general earthwork
- installing footings for overhead wiring structures
- equipment and material deliveries.

### When and where we'll be working

In November 2023, work will be undertaken in and adjacent to the rail corridor at Sefton Park.

Standard construction hours on this project are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

### Out of hours work

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours between:

- **6pm Friday 3 November and 7am Monday 6 November 2023**
- **6pm Friday 10 November and 7am Monday 13 November 2023.**

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

We will also be accepting some deliveries between:

- **11pm Thursday 2 November and 5am on Friday 3 November 2023**
- **11pm Thursday 30 November and 5am on Friday 1 December 2023.**

This work has been scheduled at night when traffic flow is reduced to minimise disruptions to motorists and improve the safety of our construction team and customers.



## What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- increased number of workers and vehicles travelling along Wellington Road, Auburn Road, Carlingford Road and Hope Street
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- moderate noise from machinery and equipment
- security cameras and motion sensors installed to assist in monitoring, managing and prevention of unlawful activity inside and adjacent to the rail corridor.

## Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts to the surrounding community
- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- directing lighting away from residents

- conducting on site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

## 24/7 Work in December

In December, we will be working **24/7 from Saturday 23 December 2023 until Thursday 4 January 2024** (no work on Monday 25 December 2023 and Monday 1 January 2024).

We will distribute more information about our planned activities and mitigation measures closer to the date.
