



Sefton Park Junction Infrastructure Upgrade

More Trains , More Services

September 2023

The More Trains, More Services program is simplifying and modernising the rail network, creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers. The next stages of the program include integrating Sydney Metro City & Southwest into Sydney's train network.

What work are we doing?

Electrical upgrades and track modifications are required to improve train movements through Sefton Park Junction.

Work in September 2023 includes:

- investigation activities, including site walks and scanning for underground services
- signalling investigation and installation work
- installation of underground cable routes
- drainage installation activities in the rail corridor
- general earthwork
- installing footings for future signalling work
- equipment and material deliveries.

When and where we'll be working

In September 2023, work will be carried out within and adjacent to the rail corridor at Sefton Park Junction.

Standard construction hours are from **7am until 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am until 1pm on Saturdays.**

A delivery will occur between **midnight Thursday 28 September and 6am Friday 29 September 2023.** This work has been scheduled to take place at night when vehicle movements are reduced to minimise impacts to traffic flow.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- increased numbers of workers and vehicles travelling along Wellington Road
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- moderate noise from machinery and equipment
- security cameras and motion sensors installed to assist in monitoring, managing and prevention of unlawful activity inside and adjacent to the rail corridor.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use to reduce potential noise impacts to the surrounding community
- directing lighting away from residents
- conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
