The More Trains, More Services program is delivering platform extensions and rail asset upgrades between Sydney's CBD and the South Coast to support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet. This program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

Construction is nearly complete!

We're excited to share that we have almost completed the platform extension work at Shellharbour Junction. During December we will be installing low voltage systems including light poles, CCTV cameras and emergency lights.

Since we began our work, we have:

- poured 150 cubic metres of concrete to extend platforms 1 and 2 by 30 metres
- installed two steel reinforcement beams that run the length of the platform extensions for support
- installed new lighting and fencing along the new extended platforms.

Holiday shutdown period

A shutdown period will occur **from Thursday 22 December 2022 until Sunday 8 January 2023**. This means no construction activities will take place during this time.

In January 2023, you may still see the construction team around at Shellharbour completing minor activities. These activities will involve site clean-up and recification work.
