More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program is upgrading the rail network to support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet.

As part of the program, we are extending the platforms at Shellharbour Junction Station so customers can safely access all carriages on the new fleet of longer trains.

We're moving in

In our most recent notification we advised you of changes to our plan to reserve commuter car spaces opposite Shellharbour Junction Station for a site compound. After further investigations, and to minimise impacts on commuters, we have located the site compound approximately 100 metres north (as indicated in the image overleaf).

We will require the space for:

- office sheds
- storage containers
- laydown of equipment and machinery
- a staff amenities block
- construction vehicle parking

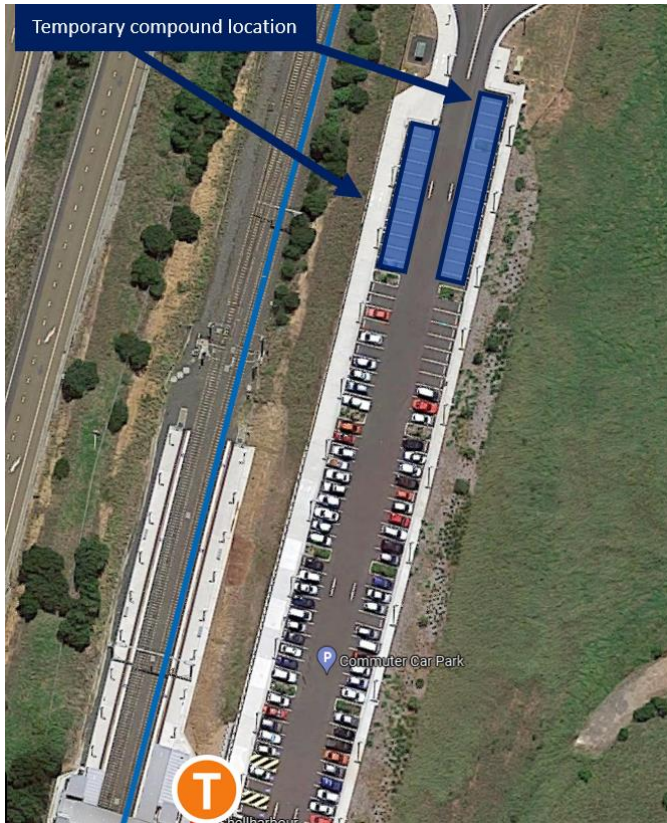
- portable water access and operation of a generator.

We will temporarily reserve 27 commuter car spaces for a period of approximately 12 months to facilitate the construction of upgrade work at Shellharbour Junction Station.

The compound will be operational during standard construction hours (7am-6pm).

We will contact you in advance on any occasion where we plan to use this compound outside of standard construction hours.

For improved safety, visual amenity, and dust containment, this area will be delineated with shade cloth. The shade cloth will be printed with the project contact details to enable members of the community to contact the project team in relation to our activities at this location.

Construction hours

The NSW Government has introduced rules to support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure during COVID-19. In accordance with the *Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Infrastructure Construction Work Days No.2) Order 2020*, **standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Sunday, including public holidays.**

All work will be carried out in line with current NSW Government Public Health Orders and Restrictions, which are subject to change.

Upcoming work

In the coming months, we will be:

- continuing construction of the access roads into the rail corridor, south of the station from the Princes Highway and Piper Drive
- starting concrete and piling activities south of the existing platforms, in preparation for extension work
- completing vegetation removal to facilitate access into the rail corridor.
