


Community Notification

Stanmore Station Upgrade

June 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Wangal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Stanmore Station Upgrade is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What work we are doing in June?

We will be:

- Installing the lift cars, as well as glazing and concreting the lift shafts
- Completing the construction of the platform canopies
- Converting approximately eight car spaces on Douglas Street into one new accessible car space, and one kiss and ride space
- Re-grading the existing shared path on Douglas Street to be DDA compliant
- Constructing the new forecourt entry area at Douglas Street, including excavation, concreting, paving and landscaping
- Reconstructing the brick retaining wall on Trafalgar Street
- Installing services and landscaping on the platforms.
 Continuing the upgrade to the family accessible toilet and close the current unisex toilet to allow for the female ambulant toilet upgrade.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working at the station and the site compound at 71 Railway Avenue. Standard working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 7am to 1pm, Saturday.

Out of hours work

Some activities are required to be undertaken outside of our standard work hours. We will be working from **2am Saturday 24 June** until **2am Monday 26 June** to install the lift canopy with the use of a crane, as well as regrade Platforms 2 and 3.

What will this mean for you?

- A crane will be set up on Trafalgar Street and the road will be temporarily closed between Merton Road and Harrow Road. See map overleaf
- Vehicle traffic will be diverted around the closure, motorists are advised to follow signage and traffic management
- Driveway access for residents on Trafalgar Street will be maintained under traffic management
- Residents along the detour route are likely to notice an increase in traffic volumes
- The pedestrian and cyclist path on Douglas Street will be temporarily diverted during regrading works.
 Please follow directional signage.
- There may be intermittent periods of high noise from machinery and equipment and truck movements.
 Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to protect road users, pedestrians and workers.


Managing our impacts
