Construction update | February 2023

The Stanmore Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents and carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Out of hours work

Some activities are required to be undertaken outside of our standard work hours. These activities have been planned during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods.

In **February**, we will be working:

from 4 am Saturday 11 February to 6 pm Sunday 12 February.

Activities include:

- installing new drainage on platform 2
- demolishing the existing retaining wall on platform 3
- installing a new ramp on platform 2
- building a new ramp at the entrance of platform 3
- installing a new services route on platform 1 and 3
- preparatory works for the installation of station furniture (bin, seats, vending machine and planter box footings) on platforms 2 and 3
- delivery of materials to and from the site compounds and station
- the above works involve saw cutting, excavation and concreting

Schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. **Please register for email updates** so we can keep you updated about our work. Refer to the contact details on the next page.

Work during standard construction hours for February

Day work is continuing **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and **on Saturdays from 8am until 1pm**. Activities include:

- closing the male toilet to allow for bathroom upgrades
- constructing lift shaft 1
- demolishing the subway wall to access lift shaft 1
- drainage and electrical work in subway

- excavation and concreting for lift shaft 2
- excavating and installing electrical and utility services on platform 1

What to expect

Intermittent periods of high noise: the use of delivery trucks, hi rail flatbed trucks, elevated work platforms, hand tools, excavators, demo saws, concrete trucks and concrete pumps. We will do everything to minimise noise and lessen any disturbance, including turning off vehicles when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers, monitoring noise levels, truck parking and truck movements.

Increased truck and vehicle movements as materials and equipment is delivered to and from the work site.

temporary parking restrictions: five car spaces at Trafalgar Street and three car spaces at Douglas Street will continue to be temporarily unavailable to facilitate vehicle access.
