

Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

Community notification

October/November 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient and enjoyable transport option.

What work are we doing?

Day time work

Our day work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

We are continuing construction at **Banksia Road from Kingsway to Denman Avenue**. Work planned includes:

- continued excavation and construction of active transport link
- temporary closure of driveways for construction work, as required
- landscaping works
- new signage and line marking.

Work at **Denman Avenue from Gannons Road to Banksia Road** includes:

- set up of temporary work area with fencing and barriers
- installation of tree protection fencing
- temporary lane changes
- start of excavation and construction of active transport link (starting from Gannons Road end)
- installation of new poles and street lighting.

Work at **Kingsway from Taren Point Road to Hinkler Avenue** includes:

- installation of tree protection fencing
- temporary lane changes
- start of excavation and construction of active transport link.

Work near Sutherland Hospital will start in October. This will include temporary detours and temporary access points for pedestrians.

Night time work

Our night work hours will be between **6pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday**.

On **Wednesday 18 and Thursday 19 October**, there will be night work to remove asphalt and resurface Banksia Road.

From **Monday 16 October**, we will work two nights a week at the intersection of Kingsway and Willarong Road to install new traffic signals. After further community consultation is complete, we are planning to work up to five nights a week at the intersection of Willarong Road and Kingsway.

What will this mean for you?

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- completing the noisiest work before midnight
- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, dump trucks, concrete trucks and

pumps, asphalters, delivery trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place for changes to access and parking
- temporary fencing for safety and security
- traffic controllers operating
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use

We will work with nearby residents and businesses and provide notification ahead of work in the area.

Parking changes

Parking changes are required during construction.

There will be temporary parking removal on Banksia Road from **Monday 16 October 2023** to prepare for work. Parking will be returned to Banksia Road once construction is complete. Signs will be in place in advance to advise of changes.

Four parking spaces on Banksia Road have been permanently closed.

Temporary driveway closures

We will work closely with residents and businesses where temporary driveway closures at Banksia Road are required to carry out construction.

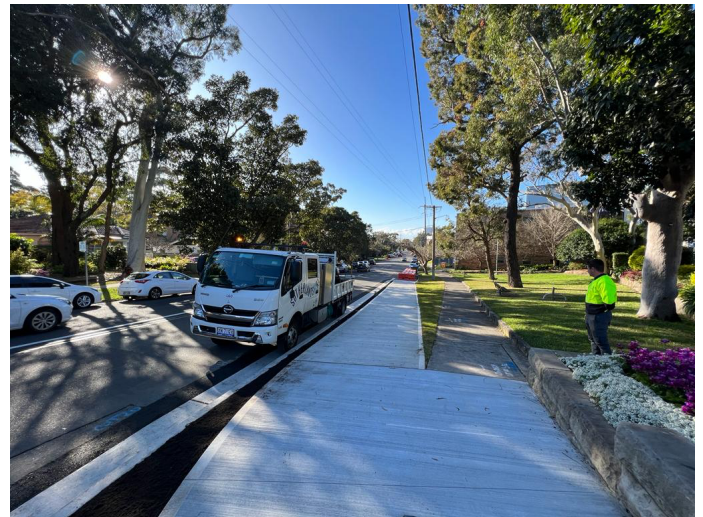
Access will be maintained outside our working hours or as arranged with residents.

Tree removal

Stage 2 of tree removal on Denman Avenue will start in November 2023. We will continue to work with the arborist to avoid construction impacting tree roots and will safely prune roots to retain trees where possible.
