Project update

For the past three years we have been upgrading rail infrastructure in Erskineville.

Work inside the rail corridor

We are pleased to share that our work inside the rail corridor is currently planned to finish in late July. We thank you for your patience to date.

Work at our site compounds

We will continue to use the site compounds at 136 Railway Parade and Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard for the foreseeable future. These will be used for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, offices, pre-start work meetings and parking while we are working in other locations as part of the More Trains, More Services program.

What work are we doing?

In August and September 2023 you may notice work and deliveries to our site compounds.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Some work and deliveries will take place outside of standard construction hours from:

- 10pm Friday 4 August to 2am Monday 7 August 2023
- 10pm Friday 18 August to 2am Monday 21 August 2023

We are going paperless

Soon we'll no longer be distributing paper notifications (unless requested) to reduce our environmental impacts.

Instead, we will contact you via email when there is work or deliveries that may impact you.

Why we work outside of standard construction hours

We aim to work during standard construction hours where possible.

At times, the compounds at 136 Railway Parade and Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard will be used to store materials and equipment when we are doing rail work in other locations, such as Eveleigh or Homebush. For safety reasons, work in these locations typically takes place during scheduled trackwork periods when no trains are running.
