

Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade – Guildford

More Trains, More Services

February to April 2023

Transport for NSW pays respect to Elders past and present, and recognises and celebrates the diversity of Aboriginal peoples and their ongoing cultures and connections to the lands and waters of NSW.

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers. It means customers can expect more frequent train services, with less wait times, less crowding on a simpler and more reliable network.

This project will upgrade the overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor to improve train movements through Guildford Station. To achieve this, the project scope includes installation of new overhead wiring and modifications to existing overhead wires.

A contract has been awarded to Next Rail, a partnership between John Holland, Jacobs and Transport for NSW, to start early work for the Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade project.

What work are we doing?

Essential investigations will be carried out **from Monday 6 February through to the end of April 2023** to assist with early planning and design. This will involve site surveying, locating existing underground services and understanding ground conditions inside the rail corridor.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

The work will take place inside the rail corridor and along Military Road as shown on the map overleaf.

What will this mean for you

From Monday 6 February to Wednesday 8 February 2023 there will be a **temporary loss of up to ten parking spaces** along the southbound parking lane on **Military Road** between Grove Street and Guildford Road. This is due to the temporary site compounds and laydown areas being established in this location.

Throughout the work you may also notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles at the site compounds and work area
- noise from machinery and equipment
- traffic control on Military Road.
