



Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade – Guildford

More Trains, More Services

June - July 2023



Transport for NSW pays respect to Elders past and present, and recognises and celebrates the diversity of Aboriginal peoples and their ongoing cultures and connections to the lands and waters of NSW.

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers. It means customers can expect more frequent train services, with less wait times, less crowding on a simpler and more reliable network.

This project will upgrade the overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor to improve train movements through Guildford Station.

What work are we doing?

Investigation work was carried out between February and April 2023 to assist with early planning and design.

Main construction will start in June 2023 and includes installation of two new footings inside the rail corridor that will serve as the foundation for new overhead wiring infrastructure. The work will involve excavation and concreting work.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor and along Military Road, Guildford as shown on the map overleaf.

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours from **10pm Friday 16 June to 2am Monday 19 June.**

This work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete the activities safely.

Temporary parking removal

From Tuesday 13 June to Monday 19 June there will be a temporary loss of **up to 25 parking spaces** along the southbound parking lane on **Military Road** between Grove Street and Guildford Road. This is to facilitate deliveries and enable construction activities.

What will this mean for you?

In addition to the temporary parking removal along Military Road, you may notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles
- deliveries of machinery and equipment
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- traffic control on Military Road.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
