




More Trains, More Services

T8 Airport Line Power Supply Upgrade Project



What's the latest news?

During April, the project team carried out the installation of cables on Wyndam Street from the Rail Operations Centre to Green Square Train Station.

What's planned next?

During August, the project team will be continuing the installation of cables on Wyndam Street from the Rail Operations Centre to Green Square Train Station.

This work will be carried out on **Saturday 7 August and Sunday 8 August 2021**, between 6am and 6pm.

These works are dependent on weather and site conditions and are subject to change.

How are we staying safe?

In line with recent restrictions introduced by the NSW Government on 17 July 2021 to help keep our communities safe, construction activities on the T8 Line Power Supply Upgrade Project are paused until Friday 30 July. We are making arrangements for our work activities to safely recommence from 31 July 2021, as detailed in this notification. Should these restrictions change based on advice by the NSW Government, which may impact the timing of our work, the community will be notified.
