Thornleigh Station Upgrade

Construction Update | March 2023

The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

What's next at Thornleigh?

During March we will be continuing work on:

- regrading platforms
- new lift fit outs
- upgrading Railway Parade
- landscaping work on The Esplanade
- preparation works to commission new lifts.

Our standard scheduled work hours remain as Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm, and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

Weekend work

To facilitate the regrading of the platforms and installing tactiles, we have scheduled this work outside of our standard hours. This work will take place from 6am Saturday 18 March until 10pm Sunday 19 March.

The new Family Accessible toilet and unisex ambulant toilet are expected to be completed during this time.

We have planned our weekend work to coincide with Sydney Trains trackwork. The station will be closed as trains will not be running.

Out of hours work will continue in March as part of the upgrade work on **Railway Parade.** We will be in touch with residents and businesses closer to the date with further information.

Parking and traffic impacts

During March, five car parking spaces will remain unavailable on Railway Parade between Station

Street and Bellevue Street to allow construction activities to be carried out.

<u>Partial road closures</u> will be in place on Station Street and Railway Parade throughout March **from 5pm until 7am, Monday to Friday**, and **all day on Saturday and Sunday.**

A contraflow (stop/go) traffic arrangement including traffic control will be set up to provide directions to pedestrians and motorists on Railway Parade, allowing for the new crossing to be completed.

Access will be maintained along Railway Parade, including access to businesses and properties, while we complete our work.

How this work may affect you

We will be using a range of equipment throughout March, including excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, concrete trucks and pumps, elevated working platforms, jackhammers, grinders, cranes, and various hand and power tools.

Our work will be noisy at times. Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with these works, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Changes to scheduled work

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be significant changes to the construction program.
