

Transport Access Program Towradgi Station Upgrade

Community notification February to March 2023

Transport for NSW is improving accessibility at Towradgi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.



Lighting has been completed on the footbridge and station buildings.

Completed work

In January, soft landscaping and custom-designed paving continued in the park on Weber Crescent, and the new solar lighting was completed. The footbridge screens were installed, work in the station office and painting was also completed.

Due to wet weather, resurfacing on Platform 2 was rescheduled to the next Sydney Trains trackwork period in April, when no trains are running, and the station will be closed.

Upcoming work

The custom paving will be finalised in February and planting in the grassed areas will be completed. Plants and turf will continue to be maintained during and after construction.

Working hours

We will be working standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
