Tuggerah Station Upgrade

July 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darkinjung people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What we are doing in July?

Work includes:

- continuation of piling activities on both sides of the station behind hoarding
- minor earthwork activities including loading of waste material off site will continue in support of the piling works
- trenching within the Bryant Drive carpark for power line works

Drivers will also continue to see construction vehicle movement and traffic control set-up on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road.

Throughout the month of July, there will be continued changes to car parking arrangements at Tuggerah Station. Signage will be in place to provide further details.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- traffic control and signage will be in place
- reducing our noise as much as possible.

Advice provided to the community in late May relating to delays to some work activities was incorrect. This piling, investigation and trenching work commenced in June as planned on weekdays, instead of the rail possession weekend which included the King's Birthday public holiday.
