Tuggerah Station Upgrade

Project update – March 2023

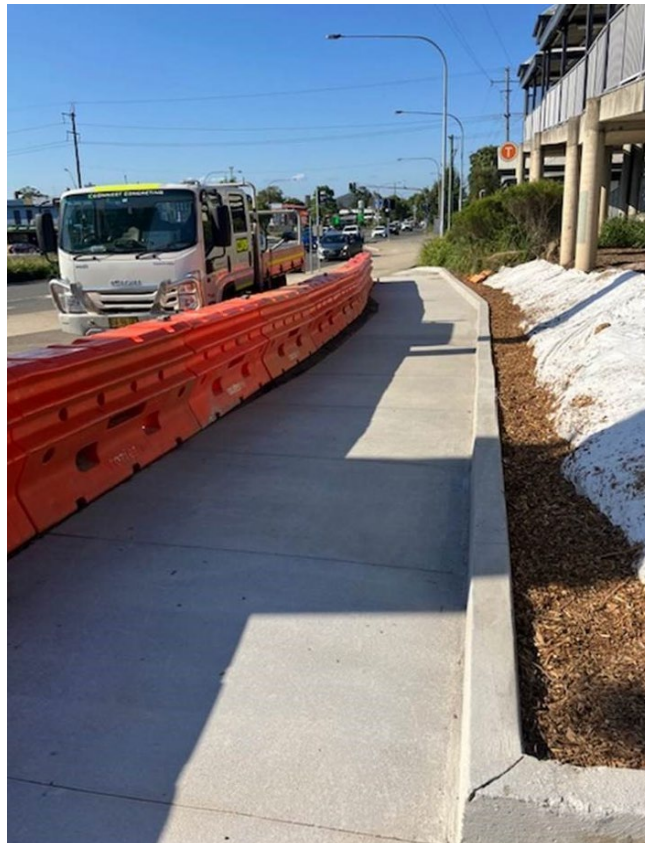


Image of newly constructed Pacific Highway footpath to station platforms.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Early investigative work on the project started in June 2022 and the construction phase continues into March.

Night works we notified you about in the February Project Update, that were scheduled to occur on Thursday 23, Friday 24, Monday 27 and Tuesday 28 February, have been changed to day works.

Work activities

Construction and investigative works will be undertaken at Tuggerah Station in March. These activities will include:

- removal and demolition of existing canopies, platform concrete slabs, entry stairs and access ramps leading to the platforms. (New temporary platform ramps leading to the footbridge which cross the rail corridor will remain until the end of the project)
- minor earthworks
- piling mobilisation
- tree trimming and vegetation removal within rail corridor
- relocation of some disabled parking in station car park.

Some of these activities will be undertaken at night. Impacted stakeholders will be notified ahead of time.

Schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, 8am to 1pm Saturday and no work on Sundays or on public holidays. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Out of hours work

From **1pm Saturday 18 March to 11pm Sunday 19 March** removal of remaining canopies and investigative and ballast ramp works within the rail corridor. Activities will include the use of scissors lifts, crane trucks, excavators, hi-rail telehandler, hand tools, lighting towers, grinders and delivery trucks.
