Tuggerah Station Upgrade

Construction update – March weekend works

Scheduled trackwork Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 March

There will be work occurring continuously from **5am on Saturday 18 March** until **10pm Sunday 19 March**, weather permitting. Work includes removal of remaining station canopies, demolition of platform slabs and completion of the platform entry ramps.

Plant and equipment used will include scissors lifts, crane trucks, excavators, hi-rail telehandler, hand tools, lighting towers, grinders, concrete saw and delivery trucks.

We have notified nearby residents and businesses who will be directly impacted by this work.

Station closure

As trains are not operating during this scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, the station will be closed and buses will replace trains, stopping on the Pacific Highway in both directions.

Access changes to station overpass

The stairs to the overpass will remain open and staff will be on site to direct and assist customers from one side of the station to the other.

Access to the existing ramps on both sides of the station overpass will be temporarily closed during these weekend works. Customers with a disability, limited mobility, luggage or prams can call **1800 775 465** at any time to arrange access from one side of the station to the other.

Signage will also be in place help with these temporary changes. Full access to the overpass will be reinstated on **Monday 20 March**.

Changes to parking

During the weekend works, up to 20 parking spaces will be temporarily closed in the Bryant Drive car park to enable the parking of plant and storage of material. Signage will be in place at this location.

Survey investigation works

Transport for NSW will carry out survey investigation at the station from **Monday 13 March from 7.30pm to 4.30am**. The investigations will assist with future planning and are expected to be completed in one week, weather permitting.
