The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Work activities

Construction works will be undertaken at Tuggerah Station in April. These activities will include:

- continuation of removal and demolition of existing canopies, platform concrete slabs, entry stairs and redundant access ramps leading to the platforms
- minor earthworks
- mobilisation and commencement of piling activities on both sides of the station behind hoarding
- tree trimming and vegetation removal within the temporary compound on the Pacific Highway
- underground utilities investigation works.

Starting in April there will be the intermittent use of a temporary site compound on the Pacific Highway at Tuggerah Station. Drivers will see an increase in construction vehicle movement and traffic control set-up on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, 8am to 1pm Saturday and no work on Sundays or on public holidays. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
